Purpose

Annual Cake Show

"Confections for a Cause" is more than just a cake show. Cakes, chocolate and sugar art pieces, and live demonstrations fill a busy weekend in early March each year as well as raise funds to help our designated charity, Ronald McDonald House. Cake and sugar artists from near and far bring and exhibit their artistry for everyone to admire and enjoy. Expert judges are also on hand to determine winners and awards in a number of categories. There is a Cupcake Corner for the kids where they can try their hand at decorating and then eat their creation! A raffle of wonderful donated gift baskets rounds out the weekend. This is a true labor of love put on by the club and is a big hit each year.

Membership

Dues are collected annually in January for the purpose of supporting the general expenses of running the club.

Meetings

Club meetings are the first Monday of each month at 7:00 p.m. (unless there is a holiday then the meeting would be on the 2nd Monday) Each meeting consists of dinner at 6:30 (donated by a member) for \$5, followed by the general business meeting at 7:00. After the meeting, a demonstration of skill or other sugar art technique is presented along with dessert. We also have a 50/50 drawing each month, a door prize brought by whoever won it the previous month, and "scholarships" which are given quarterly by random drawing.
